

## Kitchen Planning Sheet

### Start by Measuring Your Kitchen Space:

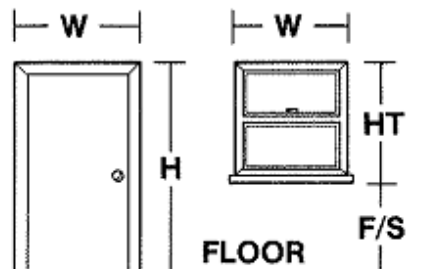
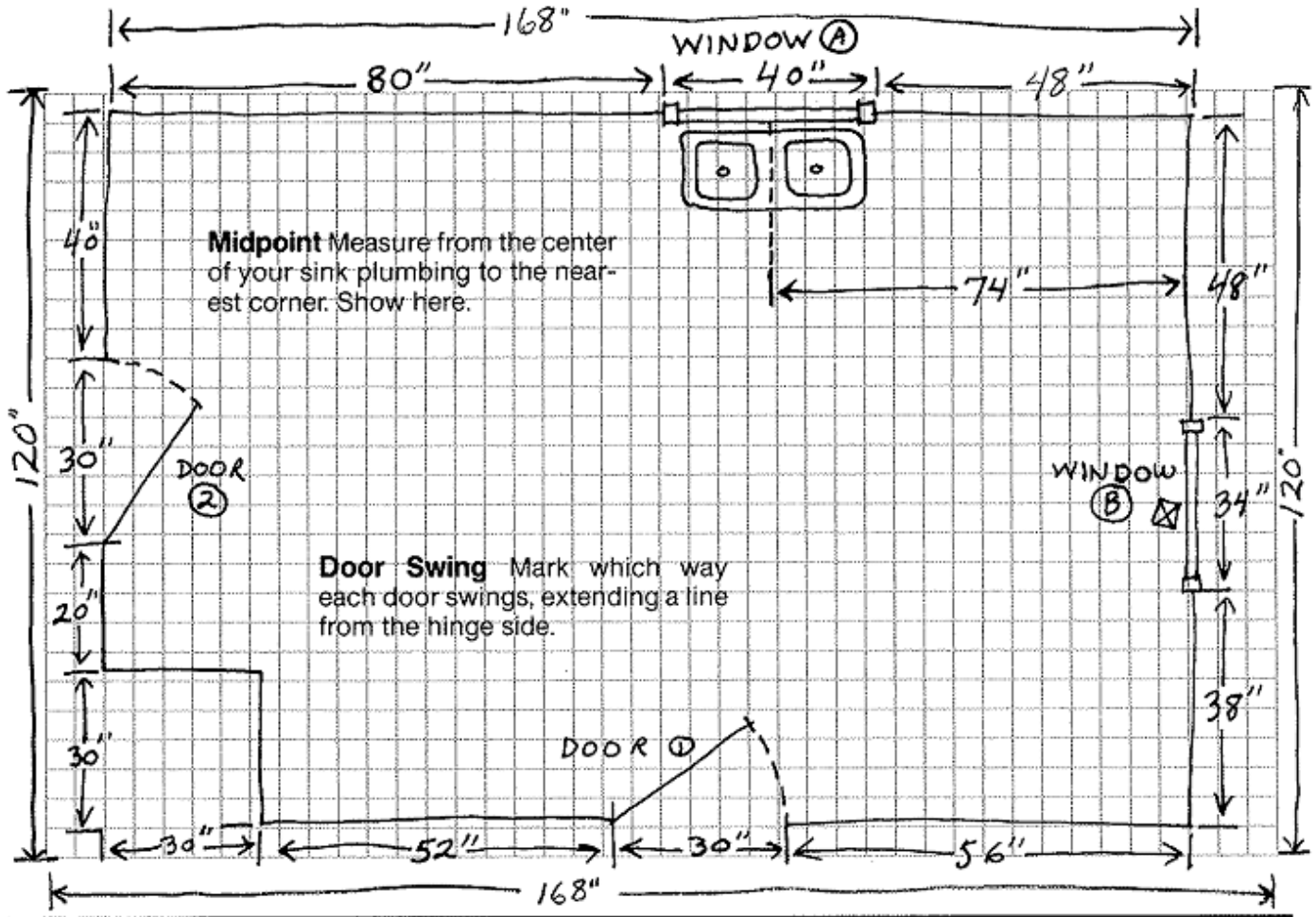
Your Cabinets Direct salesperson is trained in kitchen design. They'll design a new kitchen for you – focusing on beauty, convenience and storage. Just show them a diagram of your kitchen and they can get it started today.

Drawing the diagram is easy. All you need is a tape measure, a pencil and a simple layout grid on the back of this booklet. Just be sure you get all measurements written down. The rough drawing you do of you kitchen space should look something like this:

**Start Here:** Measure the sink window wall first. Start in the corner. Measure to the edge of the window trim.

**Windows and Doors:** Mark in width from the outside of the trim. Fill in full dimensional data at the bottom of the page.

**Continue...** Working clockwise, record all measurements of the room, noting "breaks" like doors, offsets, etc.
